

Marcus Borg

is internationally known in both academic and church circles as a biblical and Jesus scholar. Holder of the Hundere Chair of Religion and Culture in the Philosophy Department at Oregon State University until his

retirement in 2007, he is the author of sixteen books, including *Meeting Jesus Again for the First Time* (1994), the single best-selling book by a contemporary Jesus scholar.

Described by The New York Times as "a leading figure among the new generation of Jesus scholars," he has made many TV appearances. A Fellow of the Jesus Seminar, he has been national chair of the Historical Jesus Section of the Society of Biblical Literature and co-chair of its International New Testament Program Committee, and a past president of the Anglican Association of Biblical Scholars.

His last two books, *The Last Week* and *The First Christmas*, were co-authored with Crossan.



John Dominic Crossan

is an internationally repected scholar, who has authored 23 books on the historical Jesus, the development of early Christianity, and the life and letters of Paul, as well as appearing in numerous TV and

radio interviews, public and video lectures and courses. His book, *The Birth of Christianity*, was a Publishers Weekly "best book of the year" in 1998. For ten years, he was the Co-Chair of the Jesus Seminar and, for six years, chair of the Historical Jesus Section of the Society of Biblical Literature.

Born in Ireland, Crossan was educated in Ireland and the United States, before conducting post doctoral research in Rome and Jerusalem. He was an ordained priest until 1969 when he joined the faculty of DePaul University in Chicago until retirement in 1995.


