

Amy-Jill Levine

is an extraordinary phenomenon: a Yankee Jewish feminist who teaches New Testament to students in Nashville, Tennessee, the 'buckle of the Bible belt'.

She is the *E. Rhodes and Leona B.*Carpenter Professor of New Testament at Vanderbilt University Divinity

School, and describes her writing and teaching as embodying a commitment to eliminating anti-Jewish, sexist and homophobic readings of scripture.

With a B.A. from Smith College, an M.A. and Ph.D. from Duke University, and honorary Doctorates from the University of Richmond and the Episopal Theological Seminary of the Southwest. Levine has been awarded grants from the Mellon Foundation, the National Endowment for the Humanities, and the American Council of Learned Societies. She has held office in the Society of Biblical Literature, the Catholic Biblical Association, and the Association for Jewish Studies, and recorded for the Teaching Company's "great lectures" series.


