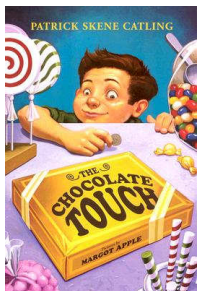
LET'S READ

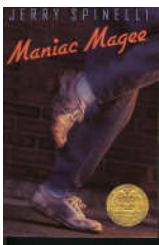
