Tour Reporters Crew

This crew will prepare the daily on-line tour diary for downloading on the DGFUMC web site with a recap of activities with photos and will assist prepare the tour video recap to be shown after the 7:00 home performance. Upon arrival at host churches, this crew will also assist in delivering luggage to appropriate rooms.

Preferred maximum number on crew: 5

Hospitality/Bus Crew

While on tour, this crew keeps the bus clean (including removal of trash) and stocked with water and snacks; decides friendly competitions or games (such as best decorated seat, cleanest seat, messiest seat, etc.); selects movies to watch, and works with the Search and Rescue Crew regarding items left behind.

Preferred maximum number on crew: 6

Load, Sound and Furniture

This crew is responsible for the loading, unloading, set-up and take down of all sound equipment for all tour performances and applicable rehearsals, including microphones, speakers, and cords. This crew will also make sure that programs, props and any other boxes needed during performances are unloaded and loaded. In addition, this crew will also be responsible for safely removing and replacing any church furniture (as allowed) for all performances (and all applicable rehearsals).

Preferred maximum number on crew: 6

Luggage

This crew loads and unloads luggage on and off the bus each day. Upon arrival at host churches, the crew captain(s) will identity the appropriate rooms where luggage and personal items will be delivered.

Preferred maximum number on crew: 20 (by tradition all females, with preference to upperclassmen)

Search and Rescue Crew

This crew makes sure we leave host churches as clean as they were when we arrived, including throwing away trash and collecting left behind items that might be auctioned off during the tour. Upon arrival at host churches, this crew will assist in delivering luggage to appropriate rooms. This crew will also be responsible for making sure that all items are removed from the sanctuary following Christmas and tour rehearsals and performances.

Preferred maximum number on crew: 6
