

Got Spirit?

In “Got Spirit?” six biblical passages will aid campers to explore different ways God reveals God’s self to the human family. In a search for God’s presence, campers and leaders will seek God as Maker of creation—Psalm 8; in moments of gratitude—Luke 17:11–18; in the person of the stranger—Luke 24:13–35; in the Church, the Body of Christ—1 Corinthians 12:1–26; 5) in moments of worship—Psalm 96; and in our prayers and acts of mercy toward others in Christ’s name—John 15:1–17. Each text affirms God’s presence in the ordinary moments of life.

Not only will campers discover how God is found in the daily scripture texts, they will experience the various ways that people of faith respond to the presence of God. Our God takes great delight in being found.

Leadership Camp!

The leadership camp is a special opportunity for all 9th and 10th graders to learn and explore what it means to be a leader. This camp is for all 9th and 10th grade students who plan to be a camp counselor. If you attended the leadership camp last year you may apply to serve as a camp counselor this year or attend a second year of the leadership camp.
