Ornamented Robe—Beautiful robe, richly decorated. Made of the finest cloth and most expensive trims. Given by a loving father to his favorite son. Highly prized.

Papyrus Basket—Sturdy, handcrafted, heavyweight basket. Made by an Israelite woman enslaved in Egypt. Held a baby while floating on the Nile River.

Beautiful Harp—Finely tuned instrument, simply carved. Used by a boy when he played it for King Saul in his court.

Crown—Jeweled crown worn by a queen. Was given as a sign of royalty and power when she won favor with King Xerxes. One of a kind and very valuable.
